DOMESTIC RELATIONSHIP Ta committed relationship between two people who live together and share a household, essentially signifying a couple living as partners, whether legally married or not.
ADOPTION the action or fact of legally taking another's child and bringing it up as one's own, or the fact of being adopted.
PRIOR coming before in time, order, or importance.
VESSEL a ship or large boat.
PROXIMITY the state of being near somebody/something in distance or time
LIVESTOCK the animals kept on a farm, for example cows or sheep
MONETARY INSTRUMENTS a form of payment that includes cash, checks, money orders, and other negotiable instruments.

CUSTOMS DECLARATION FORM VOCABULARY

COMMERCIAL MERCHANDISE Goods that are bought and sold for business purposes.
RESIDENT A person who lives in a particular place
ACQUIRE To obtain or get something.
REMAIN To stay in the same place or condition.
RETAIL VALUE The price at which a product is sold to the public.
EXEMPTION Freedom from a rule, duty, or requirement.
PEST An animal or insect that causes harm or annoyance.

PENALTY A punishment or consequence for breaking a rule or law.
SUBJECT TO SEIZURE Can be taken away by authorities.
OBSCENE ARTICLES Items that are offensive or inappropriate, usually in a sexual or graphic way.
